

Clinic Volunteer Program

The Beulah Morgan Spay & Neuter clinic is always seeking dedicated volunteers to assist with our in house clinic. Since every animal is spayed or neutered before being placed for adoption you can image that the clinic is a very busy place! Volunteers who wish to participate in this program will fall under one of these three levels and will sign up for shifts accordingly, we are asking for a three month commitment.

“Instruments” Level One Volunteer: These volunteers are trained to clean and sterilize surgical instruments. Volunteers must also assist with kennel cleaning, laundry, sweeping/mopping of clinic area and basic cleanliness.

* Required training: On the job training with experienced staff or volunteer, facility tour.

* Required time commitment: One shift a minimum of twice a month.

“Pack & Prep” Level Two Volunteer: These volunteers are trained to pack sterilized surgical instruments and prep animals for surgery. Volunteers must also assist with Instruments duties.

*Required training/experience: A minimum of 5 hours in previous volunteer level and on the job training.

* Required time commitment: One shift at least twice a month.

“Recovery” Level Three Volunteer: These volunteers are trained to assist in the recovery process. Assuring animals are waking up properly from anesthesia, trimming nails, and providing comfort. Volunteers must also assist with Pack & Prep and Instruments duties.

*Required training/experience: A minimum of 5 hours in pervious volunteer level and on the job training.

*Required time commitment: One shift at least once a week.

Volunteers are promoted based on skill, time in position, and clinic staff recommendation.
